If you look at a times tables grid, there are 144 times tables facts.

We can reduce this by thinking of the following:

- 1) The 1 times table is easy.
- 2) The 10 times table is easy.
- 3) The 11 times table up to 10 is easy.
- 4) Multiplication is commutative: 6 x 7 and 7 x 6 are the same. There is no need to learn both as separate facts.

## Now, there are only 47 facts to learn.
